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A one-day teacher orientation programme was organised in the institution on 20.08.2018.



The winning team was awarded the first prize amid cheers and applause from the audience.


Mrs. Subhas Singh delivered an inspiring speech, encouraging the students to pursue sports with passion and dedication.

Overall, the programme was successful one.



Quiz competition help students to strengthen their language skills and learn about specialized subjects.


