

↳ Print spreadsheet:-

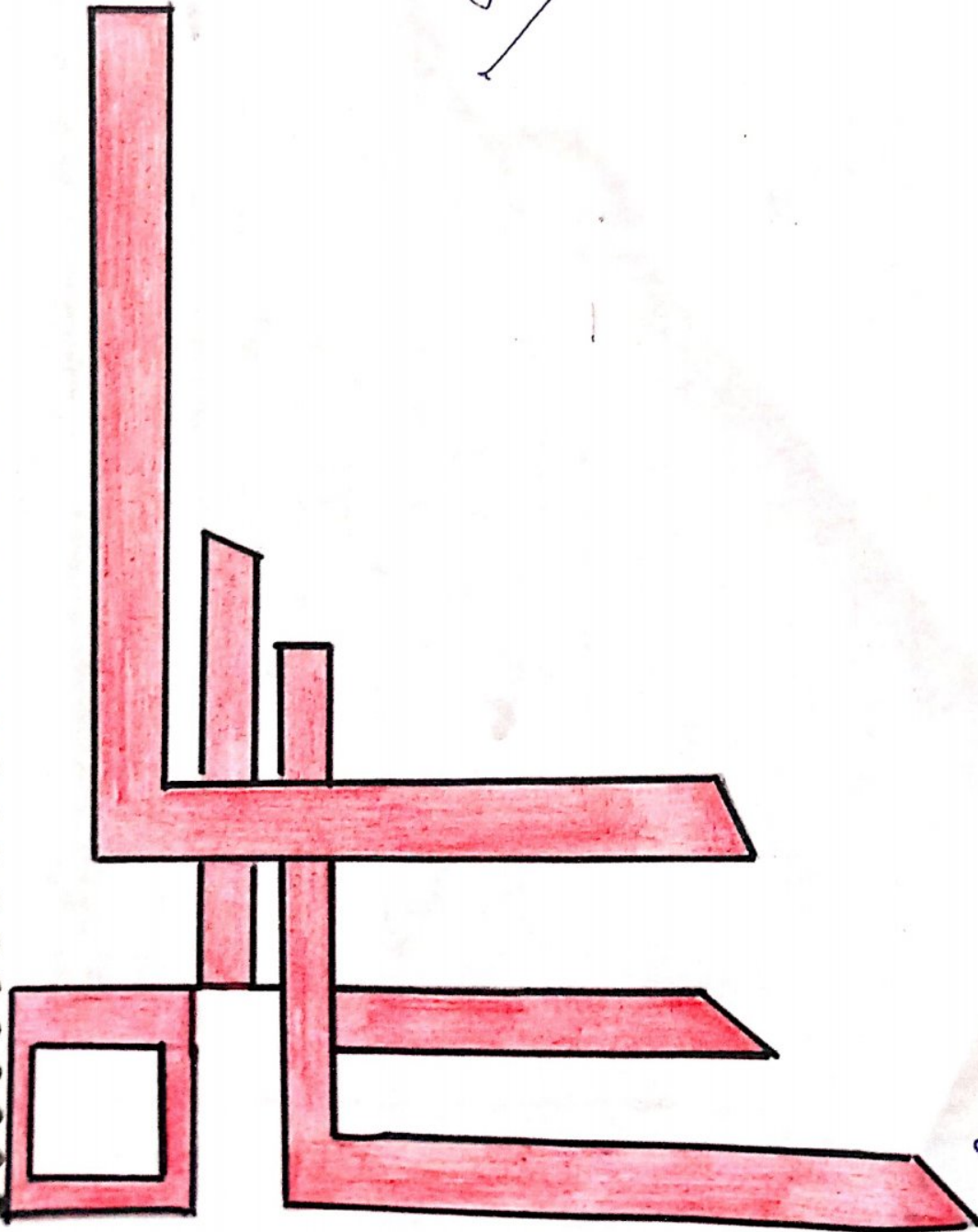
