A one-day teacher orientation programme was organised in the institution on 15.07.2022

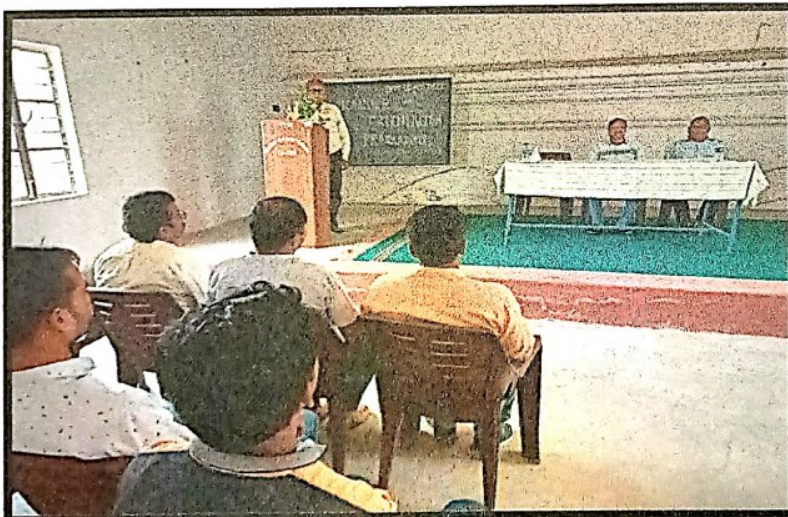
